

How to Enter a PDNDS Schooling Show:

Entries are accepted under the conditions listed herein. The entry must be accompanied by full payment of all fees. The entry must have correct and complete signatures of all persons required to sign the entry. A competitor submits his/her entry with the full understanding that it is a condition of entry to PDNDS schooling shows and any show grounds where a PDNDS schooling show is taking place, that every competitor, owner, handler, trainer, and parent agree to assume **ALL** risks of showing at these schooling dressage shows under the **TX CIV PRAC & REM § 87.001 – 005 and NM ST § 42-13-1 - 5**. By submitting an entry, a competitor further agrees that they, the owner, handler, trainer, parent, and anyone associated with exhibiting a horse at any of the schooling shows hosted by PDNDS waives all claims against the Paso Del Norte Dressage Society, the show, the show management, its employees, the facility, the facility owners and employees for any injuries to themselves, attendants, or horses.

The Entry Form must be entirely filled out.

Payment: Make checks payable to PDNDS only. Checks returned for non-payment will incur a fee of \$25.00 Failure to promptly settle indebtedness to a show may result in the inability to enter subsequent schooling shows until the debt is paid.

The Entry form must be signed and full payment of fees must accompany the entry form. Parent or guardian of all minor riders must sign entry form. No minor's entry will be accepted unless it is signed by a parent or guardian. The signature of instructors, agent or other unrelated persons will not be acceptable.

A class entry will be presumed to be an Open class unless specifically marked otherwise.

Opening and Closing Dates: Entries open two to three weeks before the show date. Entries "close" six (6) days before show date. Entries must be postmarked before closing date. No entries will be taken over the phone.

Refunds and Scratches: Refunds will be made only if withdrawals are received prior to the Closing Date (full refund minus office fee).

Substitutions: Substitution of rider, horse, or times will be made only at the discretion of show management.
